3cpl Longways Set

Tune: Statoca House - Jonny Dyer. (or a 32 bar 3/2 tune)

Jonny sent me this tune after I was in touch with him about the phrasing for the waltzes to go with 'A Distinguished Gentleman'. The title is an acronym for 'Set, Turn, And Trip Over Cat Again'. Unsurprisingly it's a lockdown tune from when we were all dancing in our living rooms and inevitably tripping over the pets who were always under our feet! When Jonny sent me the tune, I already had my 12 dances for this book, but I decided to bin off one of my other dances (which I wasn't overly keen on anyway) so this one could be included. It is also the first dance I have written in 3/2 time, so I hope you enjoy it.

- A1: 1-4 All 6 circle L ½
 - 5-8 Set & cross RS with ptnr
- A2: 1-8 Reels of 3 on side [M2 passing M3 RS at top, L2 passing L1 RS at bottom]
- B1: 1-2 All set
 - 3-8 Bottom 2 cpls [2s & 1s] three changes Rs & Ls [2bars per change] WHILE top cpl [3s] 2HT [bars 3-6] & turn single [bars 7-8]
- B2: 1-4 All back-to-back ptnr
 - 5-8 Set & TS

Progression: 3, 1, 2

Teaching Points:

I don't believe there is anything overly complicated in this one. Yes, there are three sets in there, but I think it's justified given the title!
